# RESOLUTION REGARDING DISPOSITION OF STRUCTURE AT 14601 CAVES ROAD, RUSSELL TOWNSHIP

Board of Trustees of Russell Township, Geauga County, Ohio

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2017, the Russell Township Board of Trustees met in Special Session to discuss the status and condition of the property and structure located at 14601 Caves Road in Russell Township;

WHEREAS, the Russell Township Fire Chief has declared, in a written report provided to the Board of Trustees, that the structure located at 14601 Caves Road in Russell Township is hazardous:

WHEREAS, the Russell Township Police Chief has provided written reports to the Board of Trustees indicating that the structure located at 14601 Caves Road in Russell Township is dangerous; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 505.86, authorizes the Board of Trustees to remove, repair, or secure a structure after proper notice has been given.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Russell Township Board of Trustees that:

- I. Pursuant to the Russell Township Fire Chief's determination and information provided with his declaration, the Board of Trustees finds that the structure located at 14601 Caves Road, Russell Township, Ohio, is insecure, unsafe, and structurally defective.
- II. The Board of Trustees hereby intends to remove remove the structure located at 14601 Caves Road, Russell Township, Ohio, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 505.86.
- III. The Board of Trustees shall then cause the costs incurred against said structure to placed on the tax duplicate for said property as a lien upon the lands pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 505.86.
- IV. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption.

On May 25, 2017 at 14:30 Hours, I attended a special meeting at the Russell Fire-Rescue Station, consisting of Russell Township officials, namely Chief Carroll, Trustee Madden, Inspector Wrench, Fiscal Officer Walder, Assistant Geauga County Prosecuting Attorney Kate Jacob, Melissa Palmer and Jen Dorka, in order to discuss a potentially unsafe and structurally deficient structure located at 14601 Caves Road in Russell Township, Ohio.

Through the examination of police reports, a fire report and in discussions with the police Chief at this meeting, I became aware of a situation where the occupant, namely Martha K. Fagan, and with her house being located at 14601 Caves Road, is occupying and living in a structure that is potentially in a dangerous condition to life safety.

After this meeting, I drove in proximity to the home, accompanied by Brian Harting, a firefighter-paramedic with the Russell Fire-Rescue Department, who as a practicing Technical Rescue Technician and a subject matter expert in the stability of structures, and who examined the structure located at 14601 Caves Road from the roadway and neighboring property to determine the integrity and condition of this house.

My personal observations include numerous gaping holes in the roof, which are exposed to the elements, a large bow in the entire north wall of the 2-story structure, extensive rotted walls, roofs, porches, structural member's doors and window frames and an obvious lack of both visual and structural maintenance.

Based upon the observation and letter of examination from Russell Fire Department collapse expert, Brian Harting, a review of the previous records and reports of the Russell Police and Fire Departments and my own observations, I determine and declare that the structure located at 14601 Caves Road, is structurally defective and the structure is in a condition that is dangerous to life.

Subject: House Inspection

At 16:30 hours Chief John Frazier asked me to take a look at a house at 14601 Caves Road in Russell Township. He stated there were concerns as to the structural stability of the home.

We drove past the home and looked at it from the roadway and were able to observe all 4 sides of the house.

It's initial evaluation appears that any maintenance of the home has been neglected. There are exposed structural members and dilapidated building materials with openings for severe weather exposure.

Upon further observations from the car it appears that significant structural shift has occurred. The rear entry door has shifted and appears to be open and unable to close due to racking or movement making taking the door out of it's normal rectangular opening.

The roof has visual sagging and openings that are exposed to the weather and elements. The exterior wall on the "Bravo" side appears to have the floor joists from the second floor protruding through the exterior wall. The protrusion is forming an "inward/outward" collapse potential. Without an internal observation it is hard to determine in the wall failure is causing the roof to fail or the roof failure is causing the wall to fail. This exterior wall protrudes out at least a good two feet. This can translate to reduced load bearing capability of the structure and significant movement of other internal load bearing members.

Lateral shifting or movement also appears to be taking place from the front to the rear. The front porch shows signs of separation from the main structure leaning towards the street side. The rear of the house shows signs of leaning toward the rear porch and back yard.

Given the outward appearance it would indicate that there are potentially other significant structural issues within the house and it's occupancy could put the owner and or first responders in a dangerous situation should there be an emergency situation within the structure due to added live loads or further structural degradation due to a fire or other natural event.

Title / Subject: WELFARE CHECK

14-00036

ON 01-03-2014 LT. MCDERMOTT AND I RESPONDED TO 14601 CAVES RD FOR A WELFARE CHECK. DISPATCH ADVISED THE COMPLAINANT, PATRICIA WEBER, SAID MARTHA FAGAN DID NOT SHOW UP FOR WORK TODAY AND WAS CONCERNED ABOUT HER.

WE ARRIVED AND NOTED THE DRIVEWAY WAS NOT PLOWED. WE PARKED ON DEERBROOK LN AND WALKED OVER TO THE RESIDENCE. THE COMPLAINANT SAID MARTHA DROVE A WHITE STATION WAGON WHICH WE LOCATED IN THE DRIVEWAY. WE ALSO NOTED A PICK UP TRUCK IN THE DRIVEWAY.

AS WE APPROACHED THE REAR PORCH WE SAW A HUSKY WHICH WAS ON A DOG RUN. THE DOG LOOKED IN GOOD HEATH AND FRIENDLY. WE STEPPED ONTO THE PORCH AND WAS MET BY MARTHA WHOM JUST EXITED THE HOUSE. WE ADVISED HER WHY WE WERE THERE AND SHE SAID THE WATER PIPES BURST IN THE RESIDENCE AND SHE HAD SOMEONE HERE TO LOOK AT THE DAMAGE.

SHE WAS WEARING HER COAT, HAT, AND GLOVES. I LOOKED INTO THE HOUSE AND NOTED THE STRUCTURE OF THE RESIDENCE TO BE IN DEPLORABLE CONDITION. MARTHA ADVISED US THAT SHE HAS NOT HAD WATER SINCE CHRISTMAS.

MARTHA ASSURED US THAT SHE WAS OK AND THAT SHE WOULD CONTACT PATRICIA WEBER. AS WE STOOD ON THE PORCH THE FLOOR BEGAN TO GIVE WAY FROM OUR WEIGHT. IT WAS EVIDENT THAT IT WAS ROTTEN.

AS WE WERE LEAVING WE TOOK A GOOD LOOK AT THE RESIDENCE AND WAS SHOCKED AT THE CONDITION OF THE HOUSE. WE NOTED A BLUE TARP ON THE ROOF AND WINDOWS THAT HAD BEEN BOARDED UP WITH PLYWOOD. THE HOUSE LOOKED ABANDONED AND UNKEMPT. WE WERE CONCERNED ABOUT THE STRUCTURE BEING UNSAFE AND THE WELFARE OF MARTHA. ON MAY 3, 2017 OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED FOR A WELFARE CHECK CALLED IN BY A CONCERNED RESIDENT DUE TO THE DEPLORABLE STRUCTURE OF THE HOUSE AT 14601 CAVES RD. THE MARTHA FAGAN RESIDENCE. UPON ARRIVAL, THE EAST SIDE ENTRANCE DOOR WAS FOUND OPEN. OFFICERS MADE ENTRY INTO THE HOME WHILE CALLING OUT TO MARTHA. AFTER ANNOUNCING THE POLICE WERE THERE SEVERAL TIMES, THE OFFICERS BEGAN TO LOOK THROUGH THE HOUSE TO FIND MARTHA. WHILE LOOKING THROUGH THE HOME OFFICERS OBSERVED THAT THE HOUSE IS NOT STRUCTURALLY SOUND AND IS VERY UNSAFE TO LIVE IN. OFFICERS WERE EVEN CONCERNED TO WALK INTO THE HOUSE DUE TO THE STRUCTURE BEING UNSAFE.

THE BACK ENTRANCE DOOR WAS FALLING OFF ITS HINGES AND IS NOT ABLE TO BE SECURED. THERE WAS A SCREWDRIVER WEDGED IN PLACE TO KEEP THE DOOR OPEN. THE NORTH SIDE OF THE HOUSE IS BOWING OUT AND IS READY TO COLLAPSE. THE RESIDENT IS FORCED TO LIVE IN THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE HOME DUE TO THE CONDITION OF THE NORTH SIDE TO BE UNSAFE. ALSO THERE IS WATER DAMAGE ALL THROUGHOUT THE HOME, CAUSING MARTHA TO USE BUCKETS AND PANS TO CATCH THE WATER WHICH ARE OVERFLOWING AT THIS TIME.

WHEN INSIDE THE HOME, THERE WAS MOLD ON THE FLOOR, WALLS AND CEILING AND RAW SEWAGE SMELL. THE WOODEN FLOORS AND CEILING ARE ROTTEN DUE TO THE HEAVY WATER DAMAGE AND FALLING DOWN. THIS MAKES IT UNSAFE TO EVEN WALK INTO THE HOUSE.WHILE CHECKING THE BASEMENT, OFFICERS FOUND THAT THE SUPPORT BEAMS WERE COLLAPSED. IN THE LIVING ROOM, THERE WERE PILES OF CLOTHES AND TRASH THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE HOUSE. WHEN WALKING ON THE FLOOR, THAT JUST HAD PLYWOOD, NO CARPET OR TILE, THE WOOD IS SOFT AND OFFICERS THOUGHT THE FLOOR WAS GOING TO GIVE WAY. WHILE CHECKING THE REFRIGERATOR, WHICH WASN'T RUNNING OFFICERS FOUND A PIZZA BOX AND A CAN OF DOG FOOD. MARTHA HAD WOOD STACKED UP WITH BUCKETS ON IT TO TRY AND CATCH THE WATER. THIS WOOD IS STACKED UP BY THE KITCHEN SINK AND MARTHA COULDN'T EVEN USE THE SINK. WHEN LOOKING UP AT THE CEILING, YOU CAN SEE UP TO THE ATTIC. THE FRONT PORCH AND BACK PORCH ARE FALLING APART AND IS UNSAFE TO EVEN STEP ON TO IT.

AFTER CALLING MARTHA'S NAME SEVERAL TIMES, SHE FINALLY RESPONDED FROM HER CLOSED BEDROOM SAYING THAT SHE DIDN'T NEED ANY HELP. OFFICERS ADVISED HER THAT THEY WANTED TO CHECK TO MAKE SURE SHE WAS DOING OK AND DIDN'T HAVE ANY PROBLEMS. MARTHA THEN CAME OUT INTO THE KITCHEN AND SPOKE WITH THE OFFICERS WHO ASKED IF SHE WAS OK AND SHE SAID YES.OFFICER KIMBALL REQUESTED A SQUAD TO COME AND MAKE SURE SHE WAS OK. MARTHA DID SIGN OFF THAT SHE DIDN'T NEED ANY MEDICAL ASSISTANCE. OFFICERS ASKED MARTHA IF SHE NEEDED ANY ASSISTANCE WITH FOOD OR EVERYDAY HOUSEHOLD ITEMS AND SHE STATED NO.

Mrs. Fagan's husky was hooked to a line on the back porch. The husky, Nicky, is female and about fifteen years old. Caseworker observed a dog house with blankets in it, a bowl with food in it, and a bowl with water in it. The husky appeared to be in need of grooming as there were tufts of the undercoat showing in patches. The husky's nails looked to be in need of a trim but were not impeding the husky's movement. No safety hazards noted with the husky.

Mrs Fagan reports that she just stopped working last March. She cleaned houses for a living. She does Yoga and senior exercises since she stopped cleaning houses to keep herself active and limber. Mrs. Fagan reports that she started to have stiffness when she stopped working so she started the exercises to reduce that. The house was built in 1842. She cannot financially afford to repair it. She stated that she and her husband are working to get rid of it. Mrs. Fagan stated that she feels old but she can take care of herself.

Mrs. Fagan stated that she has had the police to her home twice recently due to a concerned neighbor. She stated that each time they scared her because she thought something was wrong with a family member and was upset to find out it was the house that was the concern. Mrs. Fagan stated that the two young officers tried to get her to let them in the home and she refused. She stated that she is concerned this neighbor will continue to harass her by calling the police and that eventually they will try to force their way in when she is not home. She did not go to dinner last night like she usually does because she was afraid to leave the home. Mrs. Fagan asked the Caseworker if she will speak with the police to let them know she visited and that she has what she needs. Caseworker advised that she will speak with them. Mrs. Fagan stated that she is thinking of writing a letter to all of her neighbors to let them know what she has for herself so that they will not continue to be concerned for her.

Mrs. Fagan speaks with her neighbor in the blue home on a daily basis. Her brother lives in Cleveland Heights. She has one daughter and granddaughter in Pennsylvania about an hour and a half away. Another daughter lives in California with a granddaughter. The third daughter lives out west as well. She is in frequent contact with everyone as well as her husband. Mrs. Fagan also attends church. She declined to give the name of her church. Mrs. Fagan requested that the Caseworker check in with her and she will check in with the Caseworker now and then as well after the case is closed. Mrs. Fagan has a house phone. Mrs. Fagan also has a cell phone that she carries with her at all times. She does not use the cell phone except in an emergency. She declined to give the Caseworker this number as she keeps the phone off unless she is using it.

#### COMPLAINT

Re. 14601 Caves Road (north corner of Caves and Deerbrook) Owner: (Thomas & ) Martha Fagan

01/03/13 – Received call from Police Officer Todd Owen that he had been at the above residence and it is in deplorable condition. Tarp on roof for a long time, porch rotten, not habitable. No water since a pipe broke around Christmas, and no heat. The 72-year-old lady does not want to move out, and there was a male relative there when Officer Owen visited (had same last name). Officer Owen was especially concerned at the lady staying there due to the cold weather expected next week.

He called Job and Family Services. I said we could contact the Building Dept.

I spoke to Ric, who asked me to contact Mike Mihalisin to tell him we are concerned about the structure itself and its condition inside since someone is living in there. Ask him what we can do, and if he can look at it to see if it is sound or a hazard.

I emailed Mike Mihalisin (see attached email), and copied the Police Dept on the email.

01/06/13 – I called Mike as he requested in an email. He said he had spoken with Officer Owen, and that he also called Job and Family Services. Cammy there said she will handle the case, and they will visit the lady and take her to a hotel or somewhere to get her out of the house. Mike said he told Officer Owen that it would take a long time for him to obtain a warrant to go in the house to inspect it, but that he has asked Job and Family Services to assess the condition of the home and call his cell phone number if they want him to go into the residence. They have not yet contacted him, but when they do he will let us know what happens. He told me that he cannot just go into the residence when it is someone's home without a warrant.

I called Police Dept, Todd not there until Friday. Jayne said Mrs. Fagan called Dispatch and told them she had heat and did not need anything. Cammy from JFS called Police Dept and said they would go to the residence today, Monday Jan 6.

Per Jayre - Mr Fagar called Dispatch - said she does not read any help.
