Geauga County Real Estate Tax Collection Report

I am pleased to present the first Geauga County Real Estate Tax Collection Report. It provides a detailed analysis and visual snapshot of Geauga County's real estate taxes due and tax collection at the County, Township, Municipal and School District levels for tax years 2006 through 2011. Remember, as real estate taxes are collected a year late, Tax Year is the year prior to when real estate taxes are actually collected.

In developing this report, to my knowledge the first such work by any county in Ohio, it became clear that Geauga County is to be envied. Given the less than stellar economy, our county, from a real estate tax collection perspective, is strong, exceptionally strong! The tax base, made up of our home, land and business owners, is paying their real estate taxes in record amounts, almost \$158 million in Tax Year 2011 and near record percentages, 100.5% of real estate taxes due in Tax Year 2011. How can we collect more than is due? By the combination of current tax collection AND delinquent tax collection. Such collection results are testimony to the old fashioned values of Geauga County.

Since 2008, I have been assembling the basis of this report, always trying to keep the data in a simple, easy to understand, format. That has been the biggest challenge. All the data in the world does no good unless in an understandable form. Considering the hundreds of thousands of tax transactions and the hundreds of millions of dollars this report entails, literally, I am confident it is not "to the penny" perfect but it's mighty close. Without the capable assistance of Auditor Gliha's staff, in particular Bonnie Makowski and Bev Sustar, we would still be at square one. And without the expertise of Department of Information Technology's George Sneller, this report would not exist, period!

Finally, as this is a first attempt, it is very much a work in progress and will, I am sure, require fine tuning along the way. If you find a quirk, dropped participle or a transposition, drop a dime on me and I'll make it right.

Geauga County Real Estate Tax Collection Report Summary **Tax Years 2006 - 2011 (Collection Years 2007-2012)**

Real Estate Taxes Due

County real estate taxes due for 2011, collected in 2012, was \$162,884,291. With a population of about 100,000, this equates to \$1,623 for every man, woman and child in the county. With 52,639 parcels in the county, the average tax per parcel is \$3,094.37. Taxes levied can be as high as you want but the real determinant is how much is collected. In terms of real estate taxes collected, the 2011 real estate tax collection was \$157,963,686 which is 97.0% of current real estate taxes due, the highest collection percentage in this six year analysis.

Real Estate Taxes Collected

From 2006 to 2011, Geauga County real estate tax collections increased \$15,352,419 (10.35%). From a percentage perspective, **current** collection of real estate taxes is up from 95.8% to 97.0%. An increase of any kind in a challenging economy is an achievement. An increase of over 1% is remarkable! However, what is even more important than current real estate tax collection is the **total** collection made up of current AND delinquent real estate tax collections. For tax year 2011, total real estate tax collections was **100.5%**, the first time it's been over 100% in the six year analysis and likely in many, many years. For an entire county to collect more than the actual tax due is an extremely rare occurrence.

Current Collection of Real Estate Taxes

From a delinquent real estate tax perspective, delinquencies have seesawed with the economy. However, in this six year analysis current collections never went below 95.8% and by 2011, actually increased to 97%. That is a great indicator of economic strength.

Two Kinds of Delinquent Real Estate Taxes

There are two kinds of delinquencies; current delinquent (those who did not pay the current taxes due) and total delinquencies (those parcels with delinquencies that might include current delinquencies and prior delinquencies).

Current Delinquent Real Estate Taxes

Current delinquencies have decreased from 4.2% of current collections for 2006 to 3% in 2011. This despite a less than stellar economy. In terms of hard money, current delinquencies actually decreased from \$6.3 million to \$4.9 million. This trend is quite surprising, especially when you factor in the \$15.35 million in additional taxation. The bottom line – considering the sorry economy, from a real estate tax collection perspective, Geauga County is an amazing place.

Total Delinquent Real Estate Taxes

For Tax Year 2006, total delinquencies were \$6.6 million, 4.4% of total tax charges. By Tax Year 2009, that had jumped to \$12.1 million, an 83% increase (7.6% of TTC). Given the sour economy, this magnitude of increase is not surprising. However, in the ensuing two years (from 2009 to 2011), total tax delinquencies actually decreased by almost \$2 million (from \$12.06 million to \$10.14 million). This 16% decrease (2009 to 2011) brought the 2011 ratio of total delinquencies to total tax charges to 6.2%, the lowest it's been since 2007. This is testimony to the County's financial resolve, again, strictly from a real estate tax perspective. In the ensuing two years, total delinquencies have fallen to \$10.1 million, a 17% drop to 6.2% of TTC. Declining total tax delinquencies in a challenging economy is not to be expected. The expectation would be just the opposite but not so in Geauga County.

Geauga County School District Tax Collections

Because school funding by tax levy plays such a major portion of real estate taxes, ranging from 43.4% of the tax bill in that portion of Thompson Township that includes Ledgemont Local School District to 69.01% for South Russell Village (Chagrin Falls Local School District), it is important to see how real estate collections and delinquencies are impacting local school funding. As evidenced by the chart for all Geauga County School Districts, Total Tax Collections have been in a general upswing up to the 100.5% result for 2011. Any county would covet such an outstanding result. To have four districts in excess of 100% is remarkable. And the school district with the worst Total Tax Collection rate is Ledgemont and its 99.2%. Most districts would jump for joy with such a high collection rate. Translated, for every dollar levied, the district received \$.992 for a delinquency rate of less than 1% (.08%). A delinquency rate this low is most unusual and this is the worst in our County! The school district with the highest total tax collection rate is Chardon at 100.8%. Needless to say, such inordinately strong results cannot be sustained as the delinquent tax remaining is already trending downward.

County Comparison

As reported by the Ohio Department of Taxation, comparing Geauga (population 99,000, unemployment 7.6%) to the other 87 counties in Ohio, for 2010, the latest available, at 6.8% Geauga had the 24th lowest delinquency rate. Mercer County (population 40,000, unemployment 7.4%) on the Indiana border, had the lowest delinquency rate at 3.6%. Miegs County (population 23,000, unemployment 14.7%) on the Ohio River near the southernmost part of the state, had the highest delinquency at 49%. Neighboring Cuyahoga County is 18.7% and Lake County is 7.8%. For all 88 counties the average is 10.8%, an increase from 10% in 2009.

What does all this mean?

An overwhelming number of Geauga Countians pay their taxes on time! And most importantly, nearly every municipality and every school district is being funded at or in excess of 98% of current collection. That is extraordinarily high. Total delinquencies rose due to the sour economy, especially in 2009, but since then total delinquencies had a nice fall while the economy has plugged along at a very modest level. For 2011, Total Tax Collection is 100.5%. Simply incredible!

Foreclosure Crisis – National Impact

Given the continuing economic uncertainty, there was a general conclusion that real estate tax collections would drop significantly throughout the country. The constant barrage of national and regional newspaper headlines proclaiming the foreclosure crisis made it nearly impossible to see any positive aspect. The focus was on those few who weren't paying their mortgages when an overwhelming majority were paying. Sadly nobody reported this important fact. Had the pundits stopped for a moment to realize that most homeowners' mortgages were not in jeopardy, the nationalization of the two largest mortgage issuers, Federal National Mortgage Association (FNMA better known as Fannie Mae) and Federal Home Loan Mortgage Association (FHLMC better known as Freddie Mac) might not have required stop gap funding of \$200 BILLION which in turn would have likely greatly lessened the rush to recession.

Foreclosure Crisis – Local Impact

Here in Geauga County, bank initiated foreclosures have increased as well. The ability for financial institutions to initiate foreclosure electronically has made it so that a foreclosure can now be filed with a few simple keystrokes on a computer and one signature. The concept of a neighborhood banker or S&L issuing and holding mortgages has been replaced by a faster economic model complete with selling (packaging) mortgages, internet banking and so on. Some institutions were so aggressive they provided mortgages without bona fide appraisals nor proof of employment nor even proof of income. Known as *the subprime mortgage crisis*, what it really was, was a failure of prudent loan fundamentals. Fortunately, for the most part, such was not the case here in Geauga County where substantiation of ability to pay is still the prudent method. Unfortunately, the national economy is, make that hopefully *was*, based more on larger institutions which became addicted to these paper tiger loans. However, as the Nation is one economy, we are all in the same economic boat and must therefore pay a price, deserved or not. Due to the conservative and less transient nature of Geauga's residents and mortgage originators, the problem is significantly less than many of our neighboring counties, most especially Cuyahoga which, not that long ago, had the highest foreclosure rate in the country.

Geauga County Tax Foreclosures


Foreclosures for failure to pay real estate taxes initiated by my office through County Prosecutor David Joyce, was a whopping 12 in 2008, up from 6 in 2007. Some statisticians might interpret this as a 100% increase which makes for a great headline but the truth is that tax foreclosures in Geauga County are at an extremely low five one-hundredths of one percent. I would hazard a guess that our foreclosure rate is among the lowest in the Nation!

Conclusion

From a real estate tax collection perspective, as is evidenced by the numerous spreadsheets and accompanying charts, Geauga County is an amazing place! Our traditional values continue to serve us extremely well since our county's founding back in 1806.



Tax Years 2006-2011 (Collection Years 2007-2012)



Though the economy continues to be challenging to many, taxpayers, at least real estate taxpayers, are paying their real estate taxes in such a way that delinquencies, both current and total delinquencies, are declining. That current delinquencies have declined nearly every year since '06 is remarkable.

Tax Years 2006 - 2011 (Collection Years 2007 - 2012)**





Healthy collection rates all along with a very strong recent past. However, the trend of 100%+ collection rates is not sustainable.
















